

# IMPLANTOLOGY: FROM PLANNING TO PLACEMENT HANDS-ON TRAINING WITH LIVE PATIENTS

OCTOBER 18-19, 2014 AND FEBRUARY 21, 2015

## Course Overview

Through lectures, demonstrations, and hands-on content, this course is designed to familiarize the dentist with assessment, planning, placement and restoration of single tooth implants.

Participants will systematically learn the theoretical basics and practical procedures for simple, single implant placement and restoration through lecture, hands-on implant placement on pig jaws, and rotations of clinical technologies. Participants will receive guided one-on-one instruction as they apply the learned theories and techniques while placing an implant on a LIVE patient.

This unique and accelerated program will take you from planning to placement in a controlled environment!

## Course Objectives

At the completion of the course participants will be able to:

- Select implant candidates and present treatment plan.
- Understand how to import CT scans into treatment planning software.
- Use fabricated surgical guide and guided surgical kit for optimal implant placement.
- Use treatment-planning software for proper implant selection.
- Perform a same day temporization for single tooth placement.
- Take impressions for single-tooth prostheses.
- Understand cost effective ways for fabricating the final abutment/crown selection.
